

## PPC Meeting Notes – 14<sup>th</sup> May 2007

Fr. Walter gave an update on Parish issues and decisions:

- To date, no replacement has been named for Fr. Walter, but he is hopeful that we will receive news from the Archdiocese over the next couple of weeks.
- The Purchase and Sale was signed on the Chris the King property. Proceeds from the sale of property will result in \$200,000 to be deposited into the Parish account. Part of the proceeds will be used to pay the balance on the purchase of the Poplin site and outstanding money owed to the Archdiocese
- The Finance Committee and the PPC have composed a letter to be read to Parishioners the weekend of 26<sup>th</sup> May. The purpose of the letter is to encourage parishioners to help keep St. Michael's fiscally sound through increased weekly donations. Fr. Walter has approved the letter which will also be mailed in June to Parishioners and posted in the Bulletin 3<sup>rd</sup> June
